- Retaining as much of the existing building fabric and building interior layout as possible
- Minimal work to the building exterior
- Change of use from a 5 bedroom, 1 bathroom 132.58m² residential bungalow to an office/voluntary hub with 4 office spaces, 1 bathroom.
- Existing exterior finishes to be retained; however, the windows and doors will be replaced for improved energy performance.
- The interior spaces are also to be maintained with minimal intervention except where the new functions require alterations.
- We are proposing new raised letter signage to identify the main entrance.
- and associated services including landscaping and boundary treatment.
