**VESTING ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the land described in the Schedule hereto and shown on the map attached hereto is a derelict site within the meaning of the Derelict Sites Act 1990 (as amended and extended by the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended) (hereinafter called “the Act”);

**AND WHEREAS** the provisions of Section 15 of the Act have been complied with by Carlow County Council (hereinafter called “the Local Authority”) in relation to the said land;

**AND WHEREAS** An Bord Pleanála has given its consent to the compulsorily acquisition of the said land by the Local Authority,


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Local Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 17 of the Act, hereby order that the land described in the schedule hereto shown on the map attached hereto shall, on the **16<sup>th</sup> February, 2024** Vest in the Local Authority in fee simple free from encumbrances and all estates, rights, titles and interests of whatsoever kind.


**SCHEDULE
