Proposal: Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of Carlow County Council's intention to redevelop the former Bank of Ireland premises, Court Place, Carlow (Protected Structure RPS REF: CT38) for Community Use and Local Authority Office use.

Description of Development
The development will comprise of:
(a) the renovation, refurbishment and reinstatement of the original bank building,
(b) the demolition of some internal partitions in the non-historic extension,
(c) the removal of recent partitions and interventions in the original Georgian building, reinstating its original layout,
(d) the construction of some minor new elements ancillary to the existing structures,
(e) site clearance,
(f) deep retrofit of existing single-storey extension, to include PV panels on the single storey flat roof and external wall insulation to some of the walls,
(g) new vehicular access to the adjoining County Council car park,
(h) new site boundary treatments, public lighting, CCTV cameras, car parking, landscaping, and all ancillary site development works, pedestrian and cycle site access and services.
