Glebe land off Barrack Street, Tullow, Co. Carlow

Dear Sirs,

We hereby confirm that the title to the glebe land, off Barrack Street, Tullow, Co. Carlow, shown edged green on the map attached hereto for identification purposes, is vested in The Representative Church Body, in fee simple by:

- (i) Order of the Right Honourable the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland dated 17th October 1877 in respect of the Ecclesiastical Residence of the Benefice of Tullow;
- (ii) Order of the Right Honourable the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland dated 17th October 1877 in respect of the glebe land of the Benefice of Tullow;
- (iii) Conveyance dated 20th April 1878 made between Rev. John Lamphier Drapes of the one part and The Representative Church Body of the other part;
- (iv) Conveyance dated 26th June 1981 made between Peter Foster Verschoyle of the first part, Henry Boardman Knott and Neal O'Donel Browne of the second part, V E Properties Limited of the third part and The Representative Church Body of the fourth part;
- (v) Folio 9151F County Carlow.

We confirm that the glebe land edged green on the map is held in trust for the Church of Ireland parish of Tullow in the diocese of Leighlin and that this glebe land remains vested in The Representative Church Body at the date hereof.
